

In the search box, type one or more specific, descriptive terms or concepts, and click Search.

Make your search more specific by using multiple terms – if you’re looking for people in a meeting, try “business meeting” rather than only “business” or only “meeting.” Also, try broad subjects or concepts such as “brainstorming.”

For Editorial images, use the kind of words that might appear in a photo caption.

Combining keywords (Boolean searching)

Use	For example	To find images ...
Space (same as AND, &, or comma)	cats dogs	With both cats and dogs
OR	cats OR dogs	With either cats or dogs
NOT	cats NOT dogs	With only cats

Troubleshooting

Issue	Do this
Too few results	Make sure you have the correct content types selected. Then, click More images like this , backtrack on your search path or try Catalyst .
Too many results	Use Refine search prompts and keywords, select Search within and enter a different term, or use Find similar images to get keywords for a more targeted search.
Start over	Click New search .
Get inspiration	Try Catalyst for keyword and concept suggestions.
Lost on the site	Use the Search tab to get back to your latest search results.

Useful Keywords

A sample of terms that can get you what you want:
